YRT/Viva service changes take effect September 3

Newmarket – YRT/Viva service changes will take effect on Sunday, September 3, 2017. These changes will result in service enhancements and improve connections to major transit hubs and access to popular destinations.

Riders are encouraged to visit yrt.ca to review changes that may affect their travel plans, including various seasonal and frequency adjustments.

Route changes include:

• Viva purple: increased frequency for students travelling between Richmond Hill Centre Terminal and York University

85/85C – Rutherford and 87 – Autumn Hill: schedules adjusted to improve connections with revised GO train times at Rutherford GO Station

760 – Vaughan Mills/Wonderland: weekday service suspended until summer 2018, extended service for Halloween Haunt at Canada's Wonderland and Black Friday at Vaughan Mills Mall

High School Special changes include:

All 400 series School Special routes will be reinstated with the start of the school year

400 – Brother André School Special via Raymerville and 463 – Vellore School Special: discontinued due to low ridership. Visit yrt.ca for other route options

401 – Brother André School Special via Box Grove: routing adjusted to better service students living in the Kenilworth Gate area

432 – Aurora School Special: new route providing a direct connection to Aurora High School
